
Pewee Valley Fire Protection District Board of Trustees Meeting December 19, 2022



The minutes of the November 21, 2022 PVFD Board meeting was approved on a motion from Chris Haunz seconded by Adam Hack, and passed unanimously by Board.

Treasurer Report- The board unanimously accepted the financial reports and authorization was given to pay the submitted bills.

Chief's Report: There are 27 active firefighters and 4 recruits and 4 junior firefighters. There were 17 total incidents during the reporting period. Chief York advised the board that he has been in contact with Oldham County EMA and that should the storm this weekend cause power outages the fire stations will be open for any citizens that require assistance. The annual Fire Department awards banquet is now set for February 11th, 6pm at 314 Exchange.

1. Financial Review: Chris Haunz advised the board that the approved investments have been made and are available for online access. There are decisions to be made on a periodic basis so the chairman asked Adam Hack to update the board duties excel spread sheet to include reminders for March, June and November. A discussion was held regarding any additional investments that might be timely. On a motion by Rick Williams, seconded by Otis Florence the board approved investing an additional \$300,000 for 12 months at a 4.65% return rate. Adam Hack abstained from the vote.

5. Information Technology: Chris Haunz reported that migration has started from Firehouse to the new First Due Management System. All should be completed by January 1, 2023
